It's Back to School Time!!!!

We have all made mistakes in the past. We are all sinners. The good news is that the God that we worship is the God of the second chance, the God of forgiveness, mercy, and grace. As we begin a new season of the church year it is my prayer that we are all excited and ready for a fresh beginning.
